

Shop Scheduling

The ACW Board of Directors meeting on Wednesday, April 7th, the Board voted to extend the number of members at each Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday morning session will go from 10 to 15 chosen members. At the moment this change will mean that most people who want to come to the shop on 2 or more days will probably be drawn for all those days.

Starting this next week, the drawing for the following week (April 19 to 24) on Thursday night, rather than Sunday night.

This change means that in the future if you want to make a request for your time at the shop, that request is needed by noon on Thursday. Margi would appreciate knowing any days that you have some other activity scheduled, so that she can put a different member in that spot. The members on this shop list have been very good about contacting her, and she appreciates it. If the change to Thursday causes a problem for you, please let her know.

Each member who uses the shop must wear a cloth or disposable mask covering both the nose and mouth at all times, the entire time they are in the shop. The members at the shop and the supervisor will make sure that the large folding doors in the main room are open 2 feet from the floor the entire time that the shop is open.

FAQs:

1. Do I have to sign up to be on the overall shop user list each week? No. If you don't sign up during this first week, Margi will add you later, but you will not be among the people who are in the hat to be chosen until the following week.
2. Can I ask to be considered for all days each week? Yes, but you will only be chosen to come a second or third day if everyone else who has asked just for that day has been chosen.
3. What if someone cancels for their day after 5 PM Sunday? Will another member be substituted? No
4. Will wind, rain, heat or cold close the folding doors? No, the heat in the main room will be on, but come dressed for the weather. We will have monitors to watch whether the mask wearing and door rules are being followed. If a member is not wearing a mask as requested, the Board decided that the member will be dropped from the choosing process for the following week. If the doors are not open correctly, the Board will be notified, and they will take proper action.
5. What about buying wood or picking up toy parts? Any member can come to the shop for both those items during the time that the shop is open. They must also wear a mask over their nose and mouth the entire time that they are in the shop. The amount of time that the wood buying/toy part member is in the shop is limited to 30 minutes.

6. Can I drop by the shop just to visit? No. Until Covid settles down to a low county percentage as defined by the Board, we will only allow the chosen woodcrafting members to come to the shop.
